

Introducing a new collaboration of doctors, researchers, and patients to bring the power of precision medicine to the fight against prostate cancer. PROMISE is a registry of prostate cancer patients participating in a research study to learn how genetic differences can affect patient outcomes.



Your Genes Matter

If we want to understand prostate cancer, we have to understand genes. That's why new research on the genes of prostate cancer patients is so important. This research represents the next step in our collective fight against the disease.

PROMISE is creating a coalition across institutions and building a registry of prostate cancer patients—a genetic database so that every prostate cancer patient can understand their genetic risk and potential treatment options. When we can analyze genetic information from partners around the country, we will set the foundation for the future of prostate cancer knowledge and treatment.



It's Easy to Do Your Part



Step 1

Get Registered

Go to **ProstateCancerPromise.org** for more information and discuss PROMISE with your doctor.

All participants must complete an informed consent process before joining PROMISE. It takes about 15–20 minutes to complete. PROMISE will provide assistance for those who need it to complete consent forms. Patients can choose to leave PROMISE at any time.

Step 2

Get the DNA Kit

PROMISE will send you a simple, home-based DNA test kit. Simply provide a saliva sample via U.S. mail. The kit will screen for one of the 30 cancer risk genes PROMISE is testing. This is called genetic testing for an inherited cancer risk.



Step 3

Get Results

PROMISE will provide you with a licensed genetic counselor to help you understand what your results mean for you.

You'll discover if you have any gene mutations that affect your care plan. These results may inform you of available treatment options and previously unknown risks of family members developing prostate cancer.
